Reclaimed Engineered Flooring

These antique timbers were used as ballast and cribbage in ships that traveled the world from the 1940's to the early 1970's when the advent of water ballast systems made heavy timber ballast obsolete. Harvested during the creation of deep water ports, over 70 different species have been identified originating from South America, Asia and Africa. The timbers have been carefully resawn to preserve the patina and character developed over the years and applied to certified Baltic Birch backing to promote dimensional stability. This material ranges in color, width and character and gives a truly unique look to any installation.
